BENEFITS AND SOCIAL SECURITY

The **Self-Isolation Support Grant** is due to open for applications from people living in Scotland on the **12th October**.

Individuals on low incomes who are required to self isolate can apply to the **Scottish Welfare Fund** for £500 grants to support them during the isolation period.

COVID-19 VACCINE TRIALS

NHS Grampian is looking for volunteers aged 18-84 to participate in a clinical trial studying an investigational vaccine against COVID-19.

This clinical trial would not be suitable for those taking anticoagulant therapy (aspirin is fine) or anyone pregnant or aiming to become pregnant in the next year. Participants at higher risk from COVID-19 for any reason, e.g. due to their age, social situation or ethnicity. are particularly welcome.
